CPR AND RESUSCITATION

In an emergency call triple zero (000) for an ambulance

D DANGER	Ensure the area is safe for yourself, others and the patient.	
R RESPONSE	Check for response —ask name—squeeze shoulders No response • Send for help.	
S SEND FOR HELP	Call Triple Zero (000) for an ambulance or ask another person to make the call.	
A AIRWAY	Check for breathing Open mouth —if foreign material is present: • place in the recovery position • clear airway with fingers Open airway by tilting head with chin lift.	
B BREATHING	Check for breathing —look, listen and feel. Not normal breathing • Place patient on their back • Tilt head back (not for infants or injured) • Lift jaw and pinch nostrils Normal breathing • place in recovery position • monitor breathing • manage injuries • treat for shock.	
C CPR 30 : 2	Start CPR — 30 chest compressions : 2 breaths ADULT: ADULT / CHILD OVER 1 YEAR • Place one hand over the centre of the chest (sternum). • Compress sternum 4 to 5 cm (or one third the depth of the chest) 30 times • Continue with 2 breaths to 30 compressions CHILD: INFANT UNDER 1 YEAR • Position 2 fingers on lower half of the sternum • Depress sternum approximately one third the depth of the chest • Continue with 2 breaths to 30 compressions Continue CPR until help arrives or patient recovers.	
D DEFIBRILLATION	Apply defibrillator if available and follow voice prompts.	

Pool gates must self latching & be kept closed at all times.
Young children should be supervised when using this swimming pool.
Keep articles, objects and structures at least 900mm clear of the pool fence at all times.

This sign is produced in accordance with Building Act 1975 Chapter 8 Swimming Pool Safety and Australian Resuscitation Council Guideline 9 as at 11 November 2016 and is recommended for aquatic related emergencies. It is no substitute for formal instruction. Enrol in a CPR Course and update your skills annually.
